Pack your favourite teddy and join us for a delightful Teddy Bear Picnic filled with games, crafts, music and special picnic fun shared with friends.



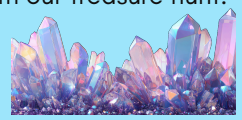
Monday 6th Rising Star Sports
